Micah Clayborne is a remarkable 13-year-old with a heart as courageous as the name implies. At the age of 10, Micah founded the inspirational company "Micah Gives" with a mission to encourage fellow kids to be brave in the face of life's challenges. Micah's motivation sprang from watching his mother's extraordinary battle with heart failure, her subsequent survival through a heart transplant, and her resilience in the face of stage 4 cancer.

Witnessing his mother's strength ignited a spark within Micah, inspiring him to channel his own adversity into a force for good. During a check up in December 2023 Micah was suddenly diagnosed with heart failure, immediately admitted to ICU and told that he would need a heart transplant.

Micah realized there were no peer support groups for teens experiencing what he was and he decided to start Transplant Teenz as a program of Micah Gives.

AS I RECEIVED THE DEVASTATING NEWS THAT MY ONLY CHILD WOULD HAVE TO TAKE THIS HARROWING JOURNEY I JUMPED INTO GO MODE, NOT JUST AS A MOM, OR A TRANSPLANT RECIPIENT, BUT AS A PSYCHOLOGIST WHOSE VERY RESEARCH WAS FOUNDED ON THE IMPORTANCE OF NAVIGATING THIS PHYSICAL JOURNEY IN A HEALTHY MENTAL SPACE. THERE ARE COUNTLESS AMOUNTS OF RESEARCH THAT REINFORCE THE NECESSITY OF PEER SUPPORT AND THE SUPPORT OF COMMUNITY DURING A HEALTH CRISIS. DURING THE COVID 19 PANDEMIC THE SUICIDE ATTEMPT RATE OF ADOLECENTS SOARED 600% CITING DEPRESSION AND LONELINESS AS THE TOP FACTORS.

AS A PERSON THAT SPECIALIZES IN CRITICAL ILLNESS I WITNESS FIRSTHAND AND HAVE LIVED THE WITHDRAWL, ISOLATION, LONELINESS AND DISCONNECT THAT COMES WITH HAVING A HEALTH CONDITION THAT LIMITS CONTACT AND COMMUNITY. JUST AS I DON'T WANT MY SON TO EXPERIENCE THOSE EMOTIONS, I DON'T WANT ANY CHILD TO HAVE TO EITHER.

Transplant Teenz supports teenagers (12+) who have undergone or will undergo organ or tissue transplant. Through our superhero-themed approach, we help TTZ embrace their unique 'transplant power' while also recognizing that it's okay not to rely on it all the time. Our theme empowers them to view common challenges such as depression, and body image, as villains they can conquer, rather than burdens they must endure. By fostering this mindset, we guide teens to navigate their transplant and adolescent journey with resilience, community, and self-acceptance.

Superhero Names

Having a transplant is a superpower, but we want to encourage each TTZ to also be able to step outside of their "Transplant Identity" and be themselves. We want to teach them that they are innately valuable. We allow this anonymity so that they find their own balance within the world of when and how to engage in the transplant space.



Villains

We take common transplant and teenage frustrations and personify them into villains. In this way the teen is able to recognize things like depression or anxiety as something that they have the power to defeat, as opposed to something that's part of them and they have to "deal" with.



Monthly Group Support Meetings are interactive and teen focused meetings that allow each TTZ to express themselves openly with a group that will hear and understand their thoughts, feelings, unique frustrations, and triumphs of the transplant journey.



Gamer Lair

This is a fun place to find other TTZ with common gaming preferences. It offers a space for virtual connection and growth without talking about transplant but understanding that the person on the other end shares your journey.



Power UPs

We all get down from time to time and team powers ups are an organized way to get back into the game. This community activity allows several TTZ to send physical and virtual messages to their downed comrade to help cheer them on.

BUDGET ESTIMATE

This is our budget estimate for the initial year of operation in which our goal is to support at least 100 Teens. Items such as Curriculum director and website development will not be necessary after the first year taking us down to a yearly budget of \$100,000

As we spend more and more time with our TTZ we want to be able to create curriculum that is consistently delivered by a master level specialist that can work with our medical, parental, and teen advisory board and compile all of that information into teachable and impactful lessons that the TTZ enjoy.

We would utilize funding to pay for virtual meeting platforms, private servers, etc as well as to incorporate gamification into the meetings as a way to interact and relate.

Funds would be used to host gaming tournaments, provide giveaways, and ultimately build a Transplant Teenz App so that the TTZ can stay connected to their peers and resources on the go.

Who can join Transplant Teenz?

Transplant Teenz is open to teenagers aged 12-18 (Or high school graduates) who have undergone organ transplants or are awaiting transplant surgery.

What resources does Transplant Teenz offer?

Transplant Teenz provides a range of resources to support teens throughout their transplant journey, including educational materials curated by medical professionals and transplant experts., peer support groups, virtual events, community resources.

THE DATA

THE CDC AND NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF MENTAL HEALTH REPORTS THE FOLLOWING:

- SOCIAL ISOLATION CAN WEAKEN THE IMMUNE SYSTEM AND INCREASE INFLAMMATION IN THE BODY.
- POOR SOCIAL RELATIONSHIPS ARE ASSOCIATED WITH A 29% INCREASED RISK OF HEART DISEASE
- LONELINESS IS ALSO ASSOCIATED WITH HIGHER RATES OF DEPRESSION, ANXIETY, AND SUICIDE.
- LONELINESS AMONG HEART FAILURE PATIENTS IS ASSOCIATED WITH A NEARLY 400% INCREASED RISK OF DEATH, 68% INCREASED RISK OF
 HOSPITALIZATION, AND 57% INCREASED RISK OF EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT VISITS.

ADDLESCENCE AND YOUNG ADULTHOOD ARE PERIODS MARKED BY SOCIAL TRANSITION. AS ADDLESCENTS STRIVE FOR AUTONOMY AND INDEPENDENCE, THEY DISTANCE THEMSELVES FROM THEIR PARENTS (<u>SMETANA ET AL., 2006</u>) AND PEER RELATIONSHIPS BECOME MORE IMPORTANT (<u>Rubin et al., 2006</u>). Adolescents that are unable to form close peer bonds do not conform with these age-related norms and might experience feelings of loneliness (<u>Laursen and Hartl, 2013</u>). Furthermore, the focus on peer relationships that characterizes adolescence can amplify feelings of difference and cause loneliness (schinka et al., 2013).

THE IMPACT OF TRANSPLANTATION IN CHILDHOOD IS SIGNIFICANT ACROSS MULTIPLE FACETS OF SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO PEER/INTIMATE RELATIONSHIPS, EDUCATION AND EMPLOYMENT AND QOL, AND OVERALL WELL-BEING. WHEN COMPARED TO HEALTHY PEERS. THOSE WITH ESRD WERE DELAYED IN ALL AREAS OF SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT.
