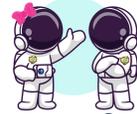

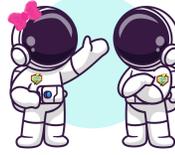

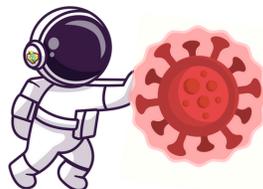

TRANSPLANT TEENZ BUDGET 2026

| Category | Description | Estimated Cost |

| Program Operations | Day to day operational costs | \$120,000 |
| Marketing/Outreach | Social media campaigns, materials, mailouts, conference table fees | \$10,000 |
| Educational Materials/Giveaways | Books, resources, and related educational enhancement the teens. | \$7,000 |
| Membership Engagement | Costs associated with building and maintaining the virtual community (e.g., squads, interactive tools, powerups). | \$10,000 |
